Papers will be submitted in English.

Please observe the following guidelines:

- ▲ Title: bold, capitals, centered;
- ▲ First name and surname;
- ▲ Abstract (100-300 words);
- ▲ 6 key words;
- ▲ Microsoft Word: Margins: Top: 2.2 cm; Left: 1.8 cm; Bottom: 2.2 cm; Right: 1.8 cm;
- ▲ Font: Times New Roman; font size: 12; line spacing: single;
- ▲ Indicate the source of quotation between parentheses: (Smith 2010:12)
- ▲ Do not insert page numbers;
- ▲ References: surname, name, year of publication, title in italics, town, publishing house. All references used in the paper should be given in an alphabetical list at the end of the paper under the heading References (indented by 1.27 cm) (font TNR 10pt, no numbering), justified. The second line of the reference should be indented by 1.27 cm (special, hanging). MLA style should be used throughout. Examples:
